International Women's Day: Isha to conduct free medical camp for breast, uterus-related disease

7 March 2020, Coimbatore: Arokyala, a healthcare initiative for rural communities under Isha's Action for Rural Rejuvenation, will conduct a free medical camp to diagnose breast and uterus related disease on 8 March 2020 to mark International Women's Day at the Isha Rural Clinic in Muttathuvayal. The camp will be held in collaboration with Sri Ramakrishna Hospital's Cancer Treatment and Research Center. The half day camp between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. will screen women between 20 and 75 years. In addition to the free screening, doctors will offer free consultation on cancer-related queries.

Arokyala makes quality medical services accessible to rural communities. It conducts several medical camps throughout the year. It also runs 3 rural clinics and Mobile Clinics to reach rural communities.

Arokiya Alai is an initiative of Isha's Action for Rural Rejuvenation, an effort to rejuvenate the spirit of rural communities through several social development initiatives that include healthcare, sports and community wellbeing.
