Isha Agro Movement to organize Turmeric Cultivation Training Program

13 November 2019, Coimbatore: Isha Agro Movement (IAM) will organize a one-day turmeric cultivation training program in collaboration with Tata Trust on 17 November, 2019 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The program will be conducted in Ganeshan Natural Agro Farm, Keelvani, Anthiyur, Erode.

The program will include interactive sessions, practical workshops, demos, Q& A sessions as well as discussions and lectures from pioneer farmers. Farmers from various districts are expected to participate in the program.

Discussions will be held with pioneers of turmeric cultivation narrating their success stories and sharing their experiences in natural methods of farming turmeric. In addition, they will also share various techniques and methods to create a better and higher yield with natural farming. The trainers will also explain how to make natural inputs specifically for turmeric cultivation which produces a much higher and healthier yield.

The experts will explain the lifecycle of turmeric plantations in detail from cultivation to market opportunities. A tour of Shri. Ganeshan's farm has also been scheduled which will be followed by a question-answer session.
